Pastor's Message - May 26, 2024.

Dear friends,

How to Receive Holy Communion?

Catholics may receive Holy Communion on the palm of the hand (allow the Holy Eucharist to be placed on the palm of the hand), following the reverent bow. Then, the person receiving Communion immediately



places the Host on his/her tongue before walking away OR directly on the tongue (stand still and extend the tongue). During Covid, we used to move two steps away and received Holy Communion. But now no more moving away but receive Holy Communion in front of the priest or the Eucharistic minister. All need to make sure that you have received Holy Eucharist before you move. Please take the opportunity before Mass and Holy Communion to instruct non-Catholics (family members and quests) in the practice of presenting themselves for a blessing, i.e., with crossed arms against one's chest). After the priest or Eucharistic minister says, "The Body of Christ" the person receiving the

Eucharist clearly responds: Amen.
