Pastor's Message – October 20, 2024 World Mission Sunday

Dear Friends,

What is the difference between church and other buildings?

Each building is constructed according to its purpose. Houses are different from shopping centres. Multipurpose halls are different from churches. Multipurpose halls can be used for a number of activities and uses. But churches can be used only for one purpose. That is to administer all the seven sacraments, offer Holy Mass, prayers and spiritual retreats. Unlike other buildings, churches are consecrated with the oil of Chrisom, consecrating the altar and the walls of the churches. It can be done by bishops alone, but not by any priest. Priests are allowed to bless the buildings, houses or articles of the churches.

What happens if the consecrated altar is broken? Even though the most important part of the church is the altar and tabernacle, if they are broken or damaged, we need to de-consecrate them and remove them from the church at the earliest. Church can have only such articles for use which could help the faithful to have more faith and devotion to the blessed Sacrament and the word of God, that is the Bible.

What happens, if someone puts some memorial things in the church? If they place them in the church, not knowing its bad implications, then they should be taught of their mistakes and re-move them as early as possible, and the priest needs to bless the church. Last Wednesday, I had to bless the church with the help John Pallone. If it happens with full knowledge, then this is a grievous mistake, and bishop needs to reconsecrate the church.
