Pastor's Message – March 2, 2025.



The Jubilee Year 2025 "Pilgrims of Hope" was officially began with the opening

of the Holy Doors in Rome on December 24, 2024, by pope Francis. We have joined the Year of Hope to our annual Pilgrimage of Faith Appeal with the theme "Journey of Hope".

Bishop Gregory Bittman has assigned for members of East Kootenay Deanery: Stations of the Cross, Radium for us to have our pilgrimage. Last Thursday, February 9th, we had our East Kootenay, Deanery meeting. All of us unanimously agreed to have our Jubilee year pilgrimage **to Radium on April 9, Wednesday at 1 pm** beginning with the Stations of the Cross, Confession, Holy Mass and Reception.



These are the conditions for receiving indulgences. All are encouraged to receive, Indulgences from the Jubilee of Hope. **Can we think of Carpooling for this pilgrimage?**

In the Catholic Church, an "indulgence" refers to the remission of the temporal punishment due to a sin, meaning a reduction in the time one might spend in purgatory after death, which can be gained by performing specific good works like praying, visiting holy sites, or doing acts of charity, under certain prescribed conditions; essentially, a way to lessen the punishment for sins already forgiven through confession, but not to forgive the sins themselves.

An indulgence does not forgive the guilt of a sin, only the temporal punishment associated with it.

Partial and plenary indulgences: There

are two types: a partial indulgence, which reduces some of the temporal punishment, and a plenary indulgence, which removes all of it.

<u>Historical controversy</u>: The selling of indulgences in the past was a major factor leading to the Protestant Reformation.







Anyone interested to have their first Holy Communion in Holy Family Church, Fernie, may meet the priest and learn the primary lessons for the same.

Bernard's Church, Elkford is short of \$ 2000/= compared to last year.


Last Wednesday, we had our Finance Council for Holy Family Church, Fernie. Holy Family is even with the yearly donations.
