Pastor's Message – March 16, 2025.

We have begun our lenten season with the



exhortation, "Repent and believe in the Gospel" may sound harsh when taken on their own, but within the context of redemption, they remind us that our time is limited, and this world is not

eternal. With humility, we recognize our human frailty, and at the same time, we rediscover the eternal truth that our lives are rooted in God's everlasting love — a love that calls us to remain with Him, and with those we love, forever.

This season of Lent offers a valuable opportunity to reflect on what gives meaning to our lives, how we spend our time, what truly matters to us, and how we can love more deeply and generously. Lent invites us to sacrifice — to "offer something up" — but rather than focusing on what is lost, we are invited to grow in gratitude: gratitude for the gift of life itself, and for the hope that flows from loving actions that enrich our lives and the lives of others.

Bishop Gregory Bittman has assigned for members of East Kootenay Deanery: Stations of the Cross, Radium for us to have our pilgrimage. Last Thursday, February 9th, we had our East Kootenay, Deanery meeting. All of us unanimously agreed to have our Jubilee year pilgrimage **to Radium on April 9, Wednesday at 1 pm** beginning with the Stations of the Cross, Confession, Holy Mass and Reception.

Pilgrimage of Faith Appeal for 2025

As a part of the diocesan Charitable fund raising, Elk Valley parishes have prescribed target. If we plan to collect more than the prescribed target, we should submit a project for the parish stating all the details and get prior permission from the diocesan office. Then, the surplus amount will be tax free from the diocese. Targets for:

Holy Family Church, Fernie is	\$17,050/=
St. Michael's Church, Sparwood is	\$ 6,150/=
St. Bernard's Church, Elkford is	\$ 1,700/=

Dear parishioners of Holy Family Church, Fernie,

I am happy that we had almost reached our goal for the pilgrimage of Faith, 2024. For the year 2025, our pilgrimage goal is \$17,050/=.

If we want to keep the Family Centre Hall for our use, we have two projects to complete.

- Purchase of Hot water tank for Holy Family Centre \$ 3,000/= and Hot water tank for the church \$ 1,300/= Total expenses for the hot water tanks \$ 4,300/=
- (2) Replacement of main floor (hallways) of the Fernie Family Centre for \$ 23,000/=
- (3) The Portico of the Holy Family Church, repair \$ 110,000/=

All these are the future projects we should think of completing within two years, if possible. If all of us think that we should keep the hall, we need to collect \$ 4,300/= in addition to the Pilgrimage of Faith. Then this will be free from Cathedraticum.

This year, let us have an affordable suitable repair to the church portico which may cost us **\$ 2,000/=**. Once we complete these projects, we can try to collect funds for the repair of the Church Portico and raise \$110,000/=



Anyone interested to have their first Holy Communion in Holy Family Church, Fernie, may meet the priest and

learn the primary lessons for the same. We will schedule it on a Wednesday or Sunday with any Holy Mass.
